We, the Clark International Airport Corporation, are committed in protecting the environment, preventing pollution, complying with the environmental laws of the Republic of the Philippines and other regulatory requirements that apply to us and our work, seeking to continually improve our environmental performance and minimizing the environmental impact of our operations.

In order to achieve this, we will:

- Comply with, and wherever possible exceed, legislative and regulatory requirements and standards of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and prevent pollution wherever possible.
- Provide information and training to make sure that all employees, service providers and contractors know their responsibility to keep to this policy and act in line with our Environmental Management System.
- Do everything reasonably possible to prevent pollution caused by all activities at the airport.
- Continually assess the effect our activities have on the environment and regularly review our objectives, targets and programs relating to any significant environmental aspects including externally supplied systems and services to support our operations. It is the duty of Airport Authority employees, contractors, franchisees, licensees and business partners to comply with the environmental performance standards required by legislation and the Authority.
- Publish details of our environmental performance each year.
- Periodically review our procedures for keeping the potential environmental risks of our activities and of any unusual or emergency situations, to a minimum.
